Palo Alto College summer children's programs available for all ages

Children throughout San Antonio have opportunities to learn science, learn about leadership, and learn to swim during summer programs at Palo Alto College on the Southside.

An award-winning program at the Children's Library in the Ozuna Library is funded through private donations and free to children entering third and fourth grade in the fall. It concentrates on Science, Technology, Engineering and Math, and this year's program is "Living It Up: Biology for Kids."

Children can select between two sessions: June 13-30 or July 11-28. The sessions meet Monday through Thursday and children choose a 90-minute morning or afternoon session. Another children's program, The Children's Leadership Academy, is designed for children entering first through eighth grades. It offers a curriculum that includes leadership, character development, English, math, science, history, Spanish, and arts and crafts. Cost is \$150 per child and \$75 for each additional sibling.
