# Enrollment and registration available on-campus until midnight at Palo Alto College

Prospective students interested in attending Palo Alto College and who want to meet with an advisor in person will be able to complete necessary steps for enrollment and registration until midnight at the second Countdown to College on Tuesday, Aug. 6.

At Countdown to College, Palo Alto will have staff members ready to accept applications, give placement tests, advise about degree plans, provide financial aid information, and accept payment for the Spring semester. It will occur from 8 a.m. to midnight in the Student Center Annex on the campus, located at I-410 South and Hwy 16.

Classes for the 16-week semester begin on Aug. 26. To register, students must have completed the application at [www.applytexas.org](http://www.applytexas.org) by Aug. 5. If they complete an application at the event, students will be able to register for the Start Two 14-week session that begins on Sept. 9.

Palo Alto College, one of the Alamo Colleges, is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award associate degrees. With nearly 9,000 students, the College also offers short-term certificates and non-credit continuing education classes. The campus is located on the Southside of San Antonio at 1400 W.
