CHAPTER 31

(Vocational Rehabilitation)

A veteran of World War II or thereafter who has a service connected disability (20% or more) which entitles him or her to VA disability compensation and who is in need of vocational rehabilitation because his or her disability creates an employment handicap, may be eligibility for Chapter 31 benefits. Vocational rehabilitation may be provided for up to 48 months, and an eligible veteran now generally has 15 years from discharge or release from active duty in which to use these benefits.
