

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT PROGRAM

Application Process

Completed application packets, including all supporting documents, are accepted in the Spring semester by the deadline of March 31. Applications are reviewed during the Spring semester for consideration to begin the OTA program in the following Fall semester.

Only applicants with complete application packets will be considered. The complete application packet should include the following:

- Completed Online Application Packet
- Complete the Volunteer/Observation Hours
 - The total hours required are 20
 - The hours must be split between to separate settings/facilities
- Official transcripts from colleges (including St. Philip's College if applicable) reflecting
 your prerequisites are required. An official transcript from the Registrar's office should
 be emailed to spc-ota@alamo.edu. The program will NOT be accepting applications by
 mail. A minimum 2.70 prerequisite GPA is required.
- ATI TEAS score summary sheet. Complete the Assessment Technology Institute (ATI) The
 Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) standardized exam with a minimum score of 65. SELECT
 THE TEST FOR ALLIED HEALTH not Nursing.
- An Essay is required for the application submission. (refer to the essay to see guidelines)
