Noteworthy Items:


- (1) Interest rates continued to rise during the into 2018- six Fed hikes over 18 months.
- (2) Decrease in market value primarily due to cyclical nature of cash flows.
- (3) All Investment Officers are in compliance with required biennial PFIA training.
- (4) All Trustees are currently in compliance with required PFIA training.
- (5) The State Auditor's Office ("SAO") completed its biannual project of investment compliance. The project includes compliance with the Public Funds Investment Act and other investment requirements for higher education institutions established in Article III, Rider 5, of the General Appropriations Act (Rider 5) and by the SAO. Alamo Colleges District was designated as both "Fully Compliant" in its PFIA compliance status and "Fully Compliant" in its other investment requirement compliant status.


