

D.4.7 (Policy) Drug and Alcohol-Free Workplace and Schools

Responsible Department: Human Resources

Board Adoption: 4-28-09

Last Board Action: 7-25-17

The College District shall establish a drug-free awareness program to prevent the unlawful possession, use, sale, manufacture and distribution of controlled substances, illicit drugs and alcohol by employees and to alert employees to the dangers of drug and alcohol use and abuse in the workplace. The program shall comply with the Federal Drug-Free Workplace Act and the Federal Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 1989.
