

F.6.4. (Policy) Automatic Awarding of Credentials

Each Alamo College may confer a credential to current and former students who have met graduation requirements. Students may choose to opt out of the automatic award of credentials by notifying the college prior to the award.

This provision applies to all degrees and certificates. In addition to the course requirements outlined in the respective program plans, students must meet other graduation and residency requirements specified in the catalog and the associated student handbook in effect at the time of the catalog year selected.
