

Enrollment Checklist

	Complete and submit your admission application at ApplyTexas.org Go to applytexas.org to apply. Allow 3-5 business days for processing.
	Complete and Submit your FAFSA application at FAFSA.gov Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.gov. Please allow a minimum of four months to complete the financial aid process. SAC Federal School Code: 009163. Visit http://http://alamo.edu.district/financial-aid for Priority Processing and Guarantee Dates.
	Submit all official high school and other college transcripts/GED scores Official, sealed documents can be submitted in person, mailed to San Antonio College Admissions & Records-FAC 216, 1819 N. Main Ave., San Antonio Texas 78212 or sent electronically from your previous institution.
	Login to ACES Account Visit alamoaces.alamo.edu to access your ACES account. Click "Get My ACES Username" and follow the instructions for the default password to log in for the first time. Contact the help desk at 210-486-0777 for assistance.
	☐ Activate Your Navigate Checklist Click "Start Here" tab, then "Navigate" to access your personalized enrollment checklist.
	Submit proof of your Bacterial Meningitis vaccine, if applicable Texas state law requires that all entering students, under the age of 22, show evidence of receiving a bacterial meningitis vaccination during the five-year period prior to enrollment; the law allows for a few exemptions. Submit documents through your ACES Navigate tab.
	Complete all of the necessary modules on Alamo.edu/AlamoEnroll Click on your ACES Navigate tab to complete the Go FAAR and Test Prep Modules (if applicable). For technical assistance with the modules, call 210-486-0777, option 7.
	Take the TSI college readiness exam, if required The Assessment Center, located in the Fletcher Administration Center (FAC) 112, determines if transcripts contain appropriate credits to meet the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirement. A list of TSI exemptions are online at alamo.edu/sac/testing-center. Complete exam fee is \$32.
	Visit Post-Assessment Advising Immediately after testing, students receive post-assessment advising, located in FAC 105. Some students may be required to take a refresher course before proceeding with the enrollment process. Contact Post-Assessment Advising at 210-486-0450 with any questions.
	Complete New Student Orientation & Register for Classes Students with fewer than 15 college credit hours are required to sign up for New Student Orientation (NSO) before registering. Sign up at alamo.edu/sac/orientation or via your ACES Navigate tab.
	Pay your bill on time or your classes will be dropped Make tuition payments in person at the Business Office (FAC 201) or online via your ACES Navigate tab. Make full payment or set up an installment plan before the deadlines to avoid being dropped.
