

## Calendar of Events for General Election to be held May 7, 2022

First business day for candidates to file application	January 19, 2022
Last day to file application (deadline is 5 p.m.)	February 18, 2022
Drawing for place on the ballot	February 28, 2022 (4:00 p.m. at District office: Room 100)
*First candidate campaign finance report due	January 18, 2022
*Second candidate campaign finance report due	July 15, 2022
Early Voting period	April 25, 2022 – May 3, 2022

### Eligibility for Trustee Position

To be eligible to be a candidate, a person must be:

- (1) be a United States citizen;
- (2) be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election;
- (3) have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be:
  - a. totally mentally incapacitated; or
  - b. partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;
- (4) have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- (5) have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and the territory from which the office is elected for six months immediately preceding the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot;
- (6) on the date described by Subdivisions (5), be registered to vote in the territory from which the office is elected; and
- (7) satisfy any other eligibility requirements prescribed by law for the office.

\*Dates for filing semiannual reports only. Other reports with different deadlines may be required. Candidates and officeholders are responsible for knowing all finance report filing deadlines.
