## High School Programs Terminology

<b>Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)</b> <i>Varies per Category</i>	Agreement between two or more parties outlining the stipulations per stakeholder (Alamo Colleges District, Northeast Lakeview College, and the Independent School District, Charter School, Private School, or Home Schooling Parent).
<b>High School Programs Course Agreement</b> <i>Valid 3 Academic Years</i>	Agreement designed per course requested by the high school for dual enrollment agreed upon by the ISD's Curriculum Specialist and Northeast Lakeview College Department Chair. Agreement outlines course information (including instructional material), faculty qualifications and requirements, and student requirements. Agreement is valid for three academic years from the approved term unless change is made to course. Current syllabus must be submitted with each Course Agreement.
<b>High School Programs Annual Agreement</b> <i>Valid 1 Academic Year</i>	Annual agreement between Northeast Lakeview College and participating High School documenting the dual credit courses that may be awarded to High School Programs students as college credit. Agreement is reviewed and agreed upon by the High School principal (or designated signer) and College Vice President for Academic Success.
<b>High School Programs Verification of Eligibility</b> <i>Valid 1 Academic Year</i>	Document to be completed by designated signer validating that the following is applicable for dual credit participants: completed ApplyTexas application, completed AlamoENROLL modules, completed TSI Assessment and/or alternative test(s) to qualify for college readiness for the program, appropriate Bacterial Meningitis documentation per school records, and good academic standing at the high school. Although no course detail noted on this document, this form will serve as an unofficial transcript.
<b>High School Recommendation (HSR)</b> <i>Valid for Identified Term</i> <b>*HSR for Early Admit Only</b>	High School liaison compiles and sends recommendation list (roster) to college liaison with student name(s) and recommended course(s). College liaison will review student(s) eligibility requirements and enroll qualified student(s) on recommended list. Appropriate high school official(s) and parent/guardian completes and signs Early Admissions Recommendation/Parent Consent
<b>Student/Parent Consent Form</b> <i>Valid through program participation</i>	Agreement outlining the responsibilities to enroll and while participating in the high school program. Requires student, parent, and college liaison signature during the enrollment process prior to registration in course(s).
<b>Vendor Invoice Registration Form</b> <i>Valid through program participation</i>	Form required for new third-party partners to establish a vendor account in Alamo Colleges District Banner system with pertinent contact information. Form certifies that the third-party agrees to be invoiced for services received and/or sponsoring.
<b>Cost Share Model (School)</b> <i>Valid per signed MOU</i>	Based on which stakeholder contracts the Dual Credit faculty (based on census date enrollment per part of term): When the School District contracts the Dual Credit faculty, Alamo Colleges District will pay \$600 per course section with enrollment of 15 students or more on census date. When the College contracts the Dual Credit faculty (face-to-face or online format), the School District will pay Alamo Colleges District: \$100 per student if the ISD enrollment is less than 80% of the total section enrollment. \$2,800 per section if the ISD enrollment is equal to or greater than 80% of the total section enrollment.
<b>Cost Share Model (Home School)</b> <i>Valid per signed MOU</i>	When the College contracts the Dual Credit faculty (face-to-face or online format) and the Home School Student is enrolled, the Homeschooling Parent will pay the Alamo Colleges District a non-refundable fee of \$100 per student per section enrolled on the College's census date per part of term.
