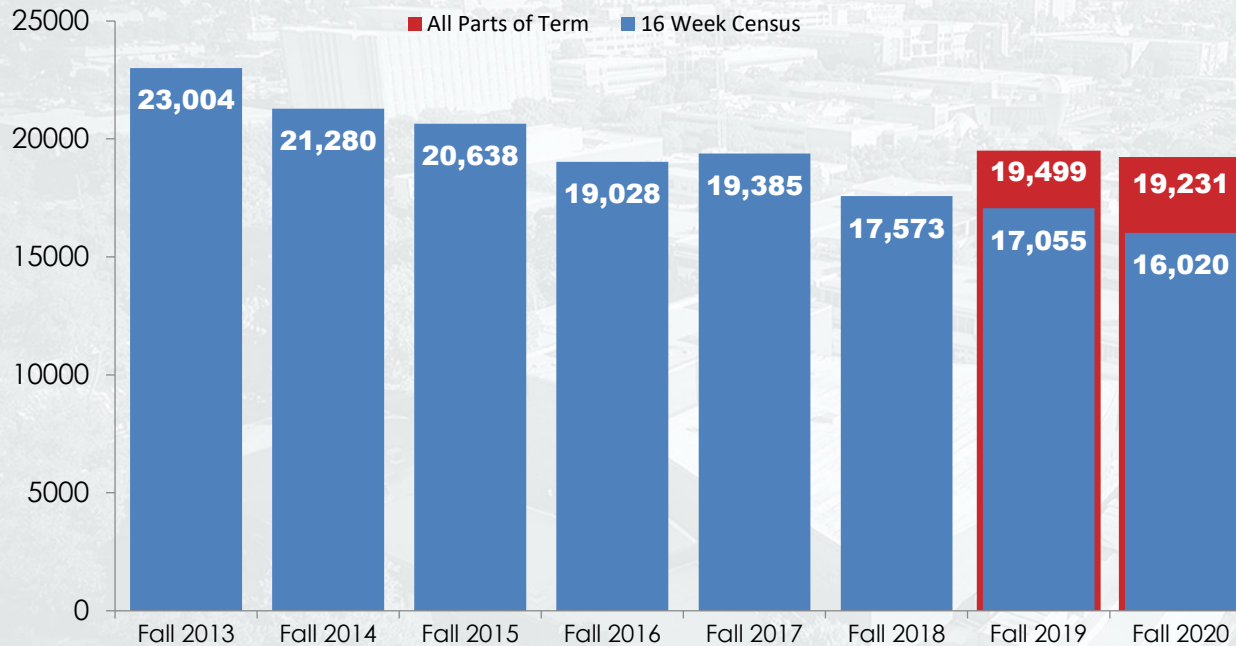

Enrollment by Student Type (All Parts of Term)

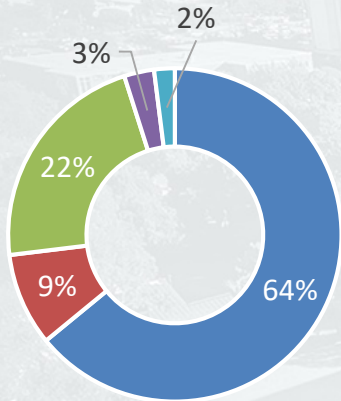

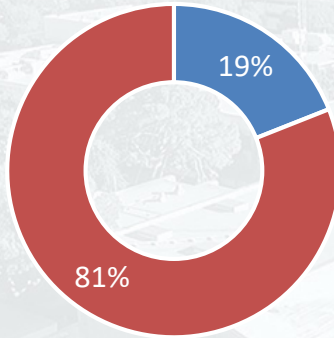

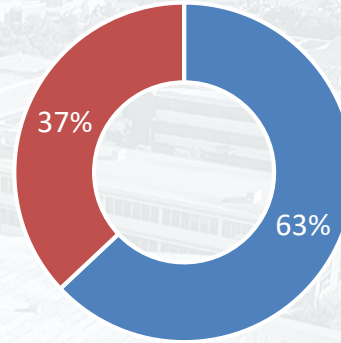

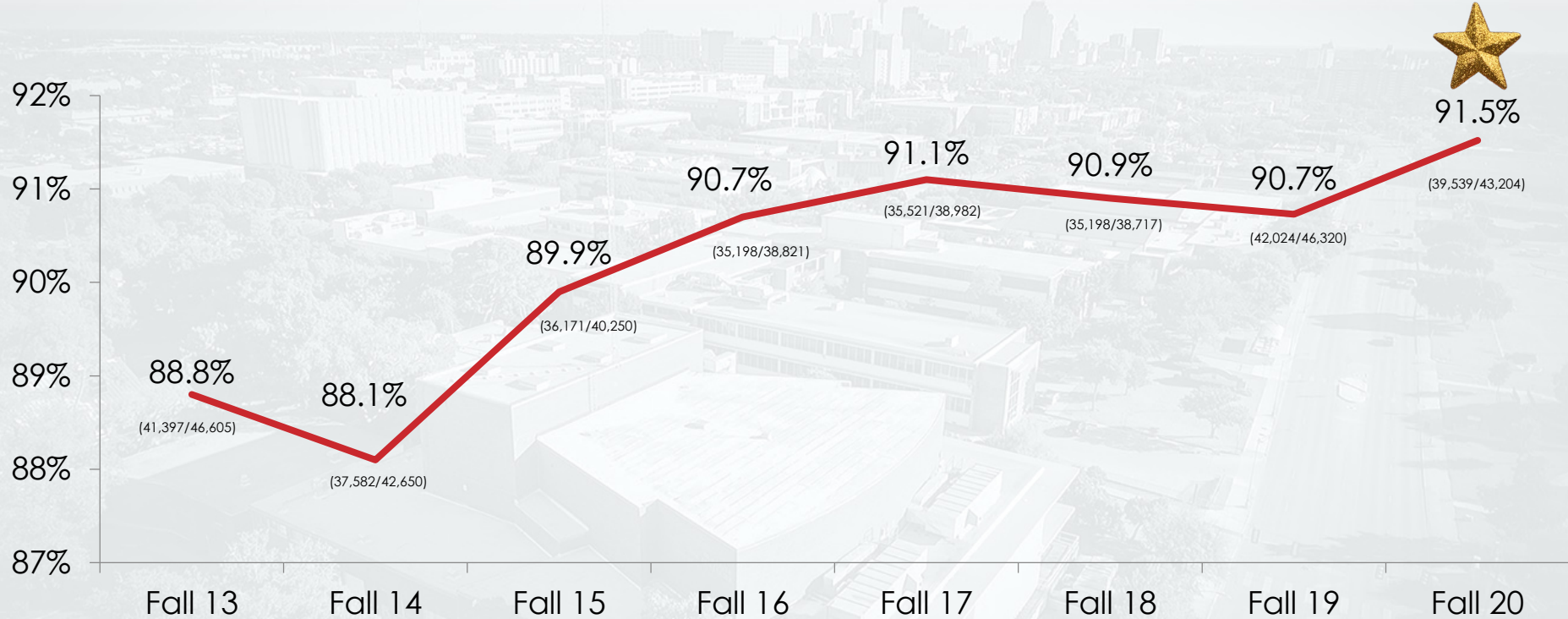

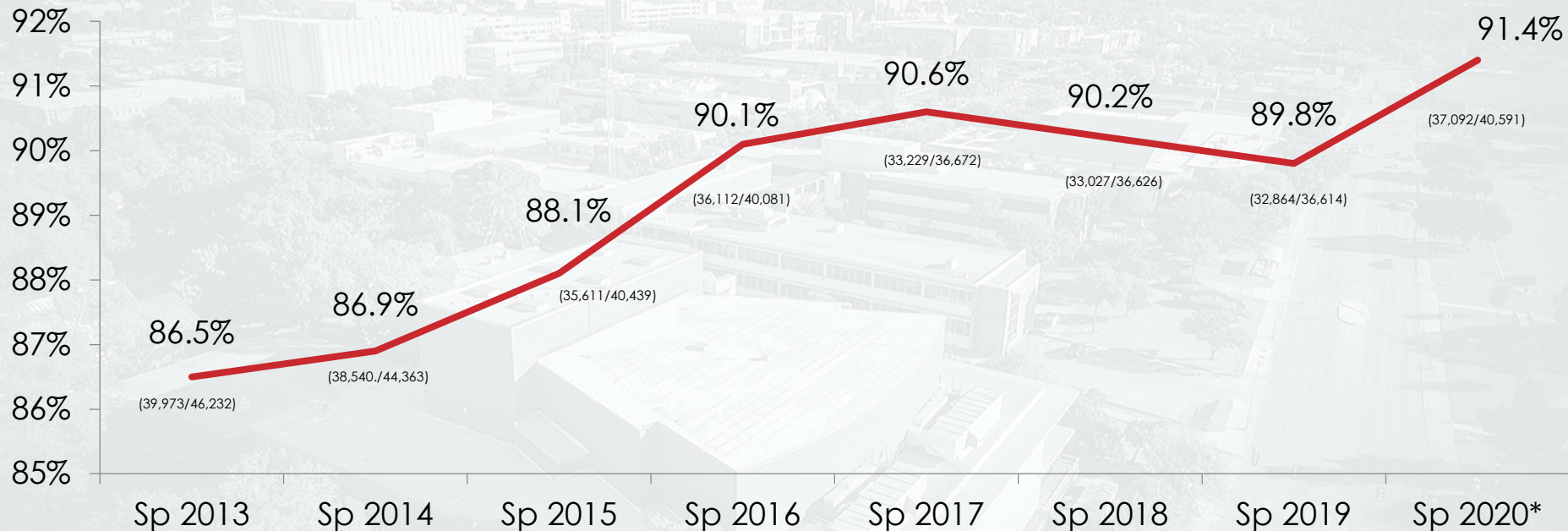

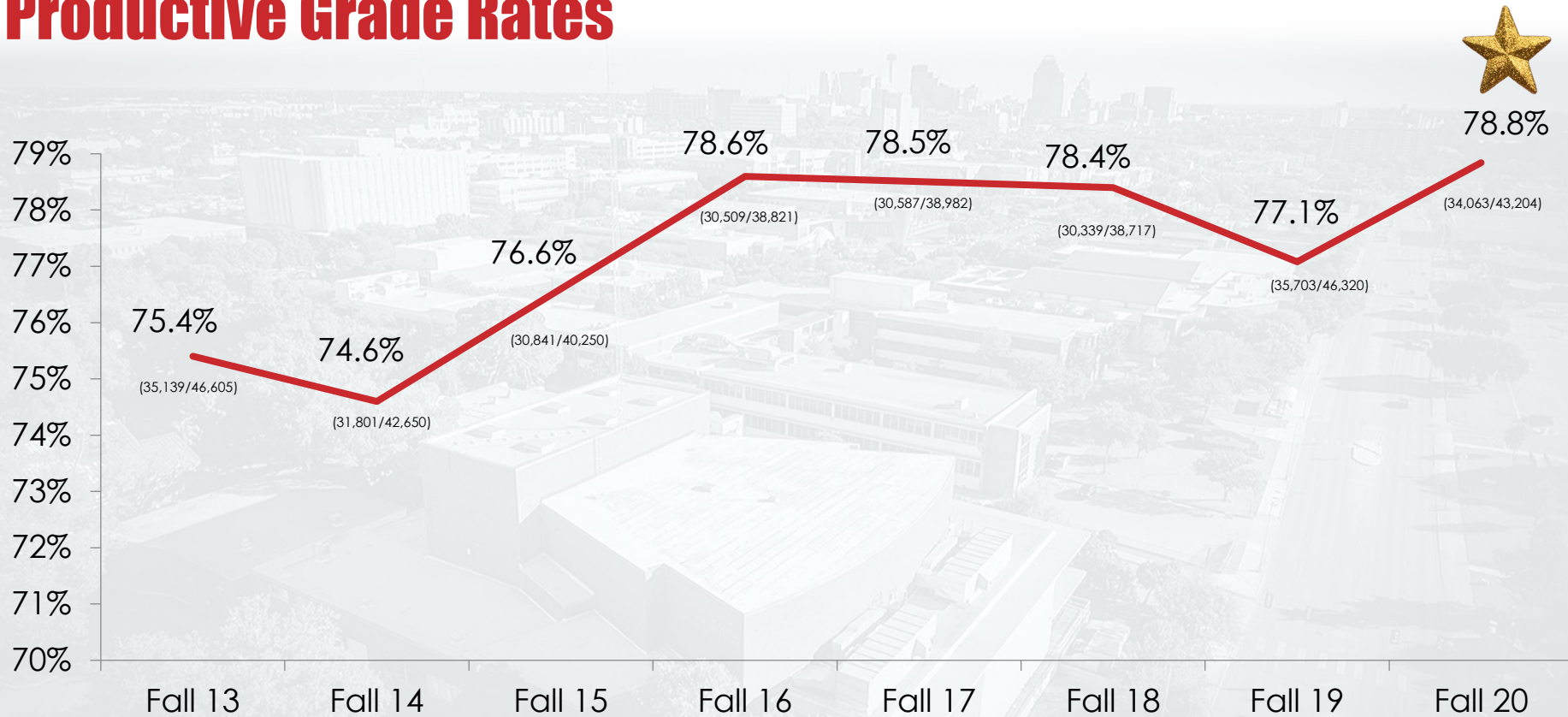

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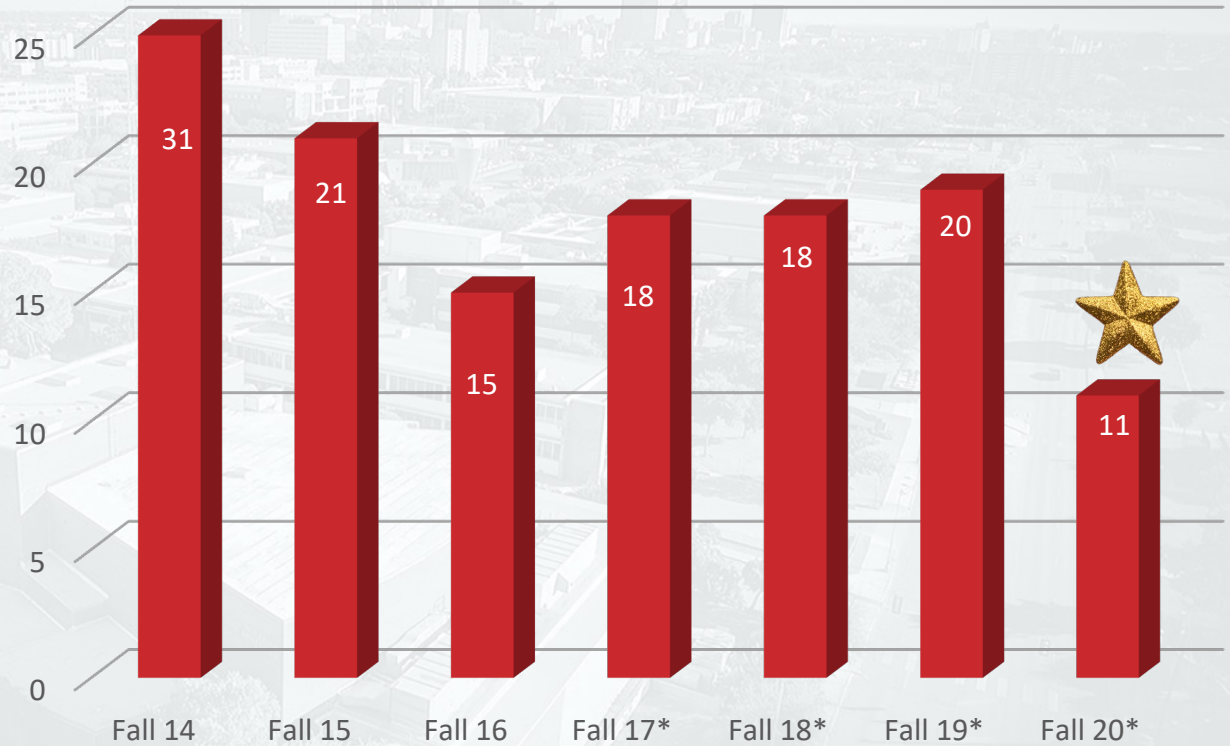

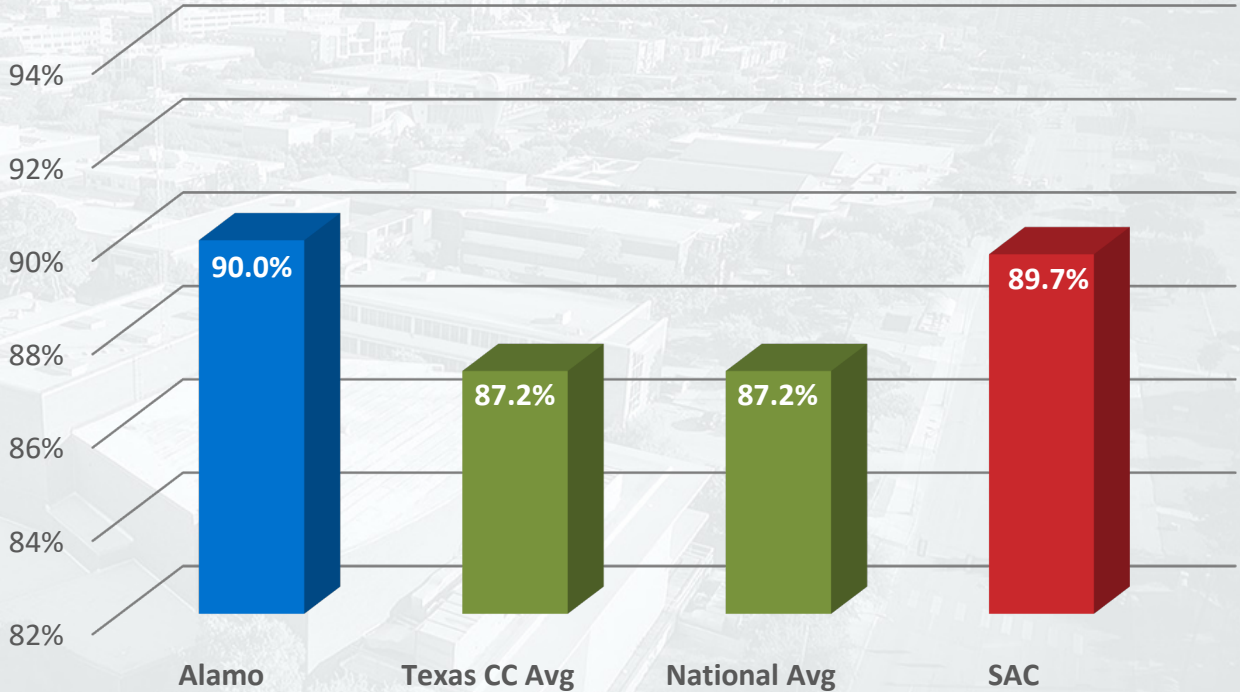

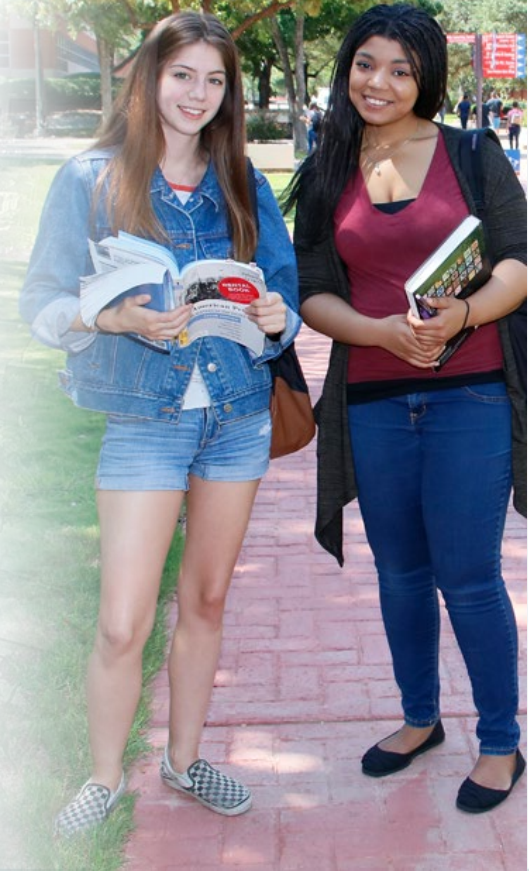
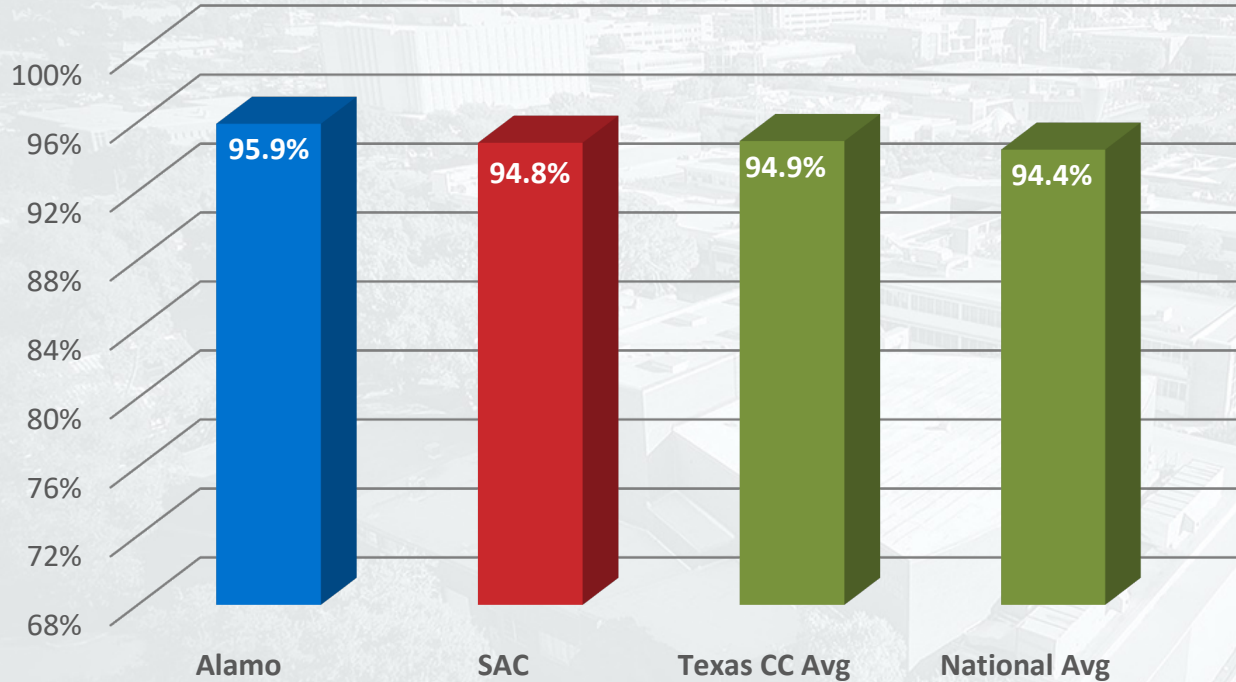
Percentage of Students Rating their Entire Educational Experience as “Good or Excellent”



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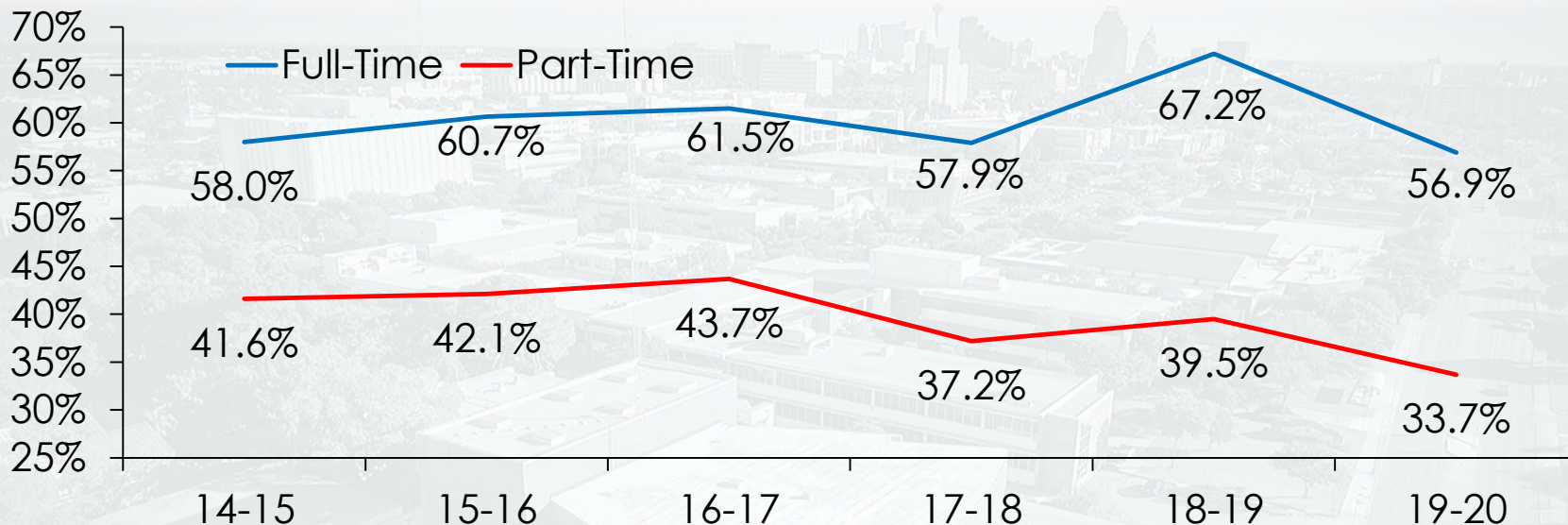

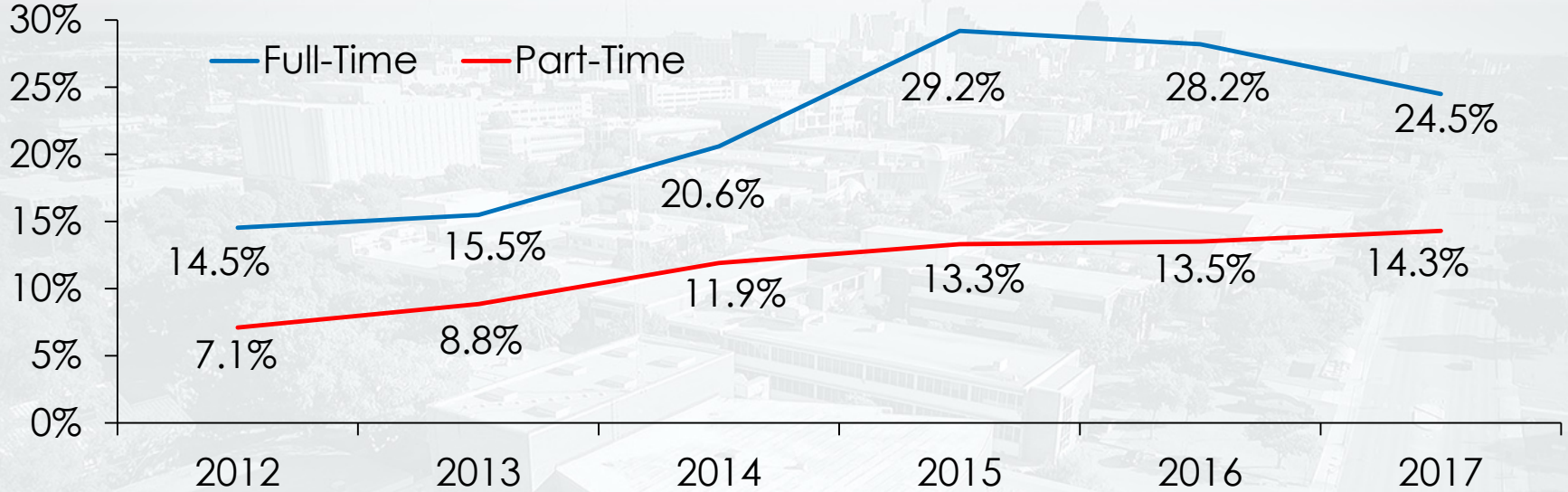

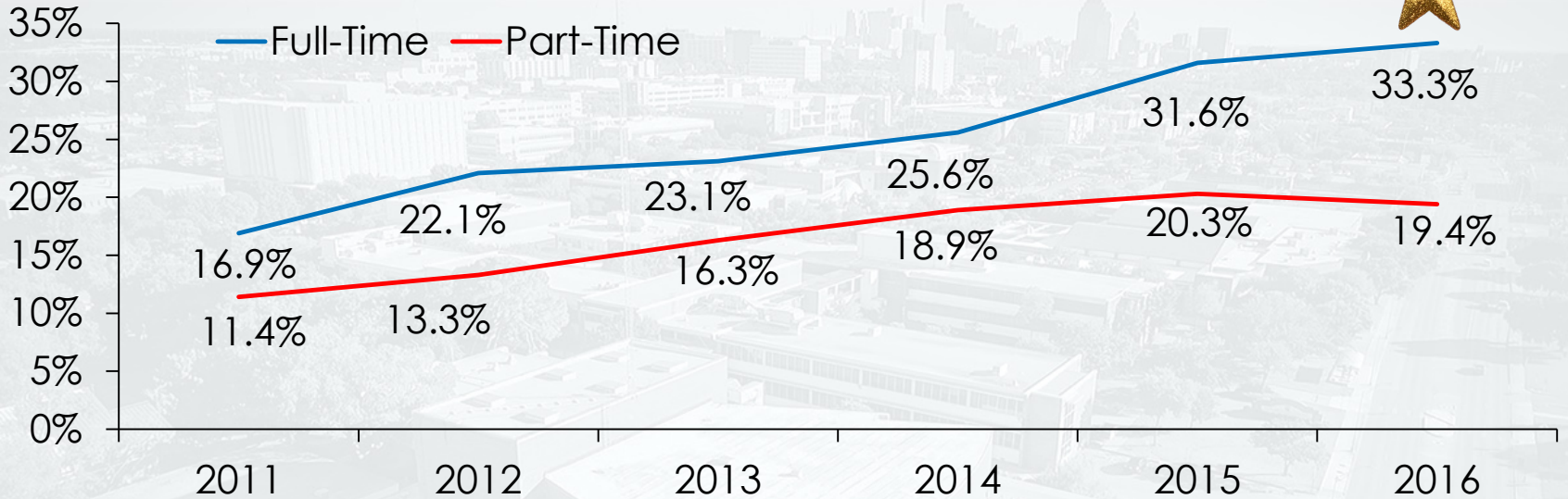

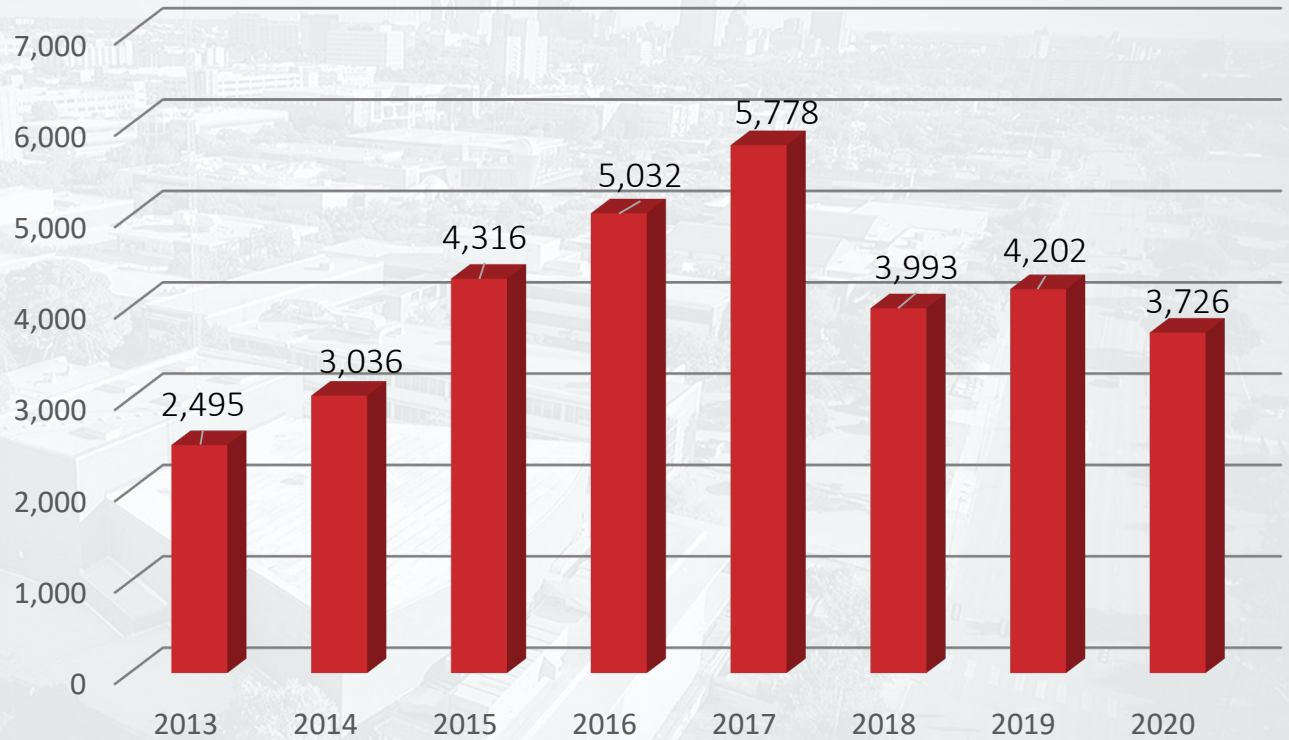

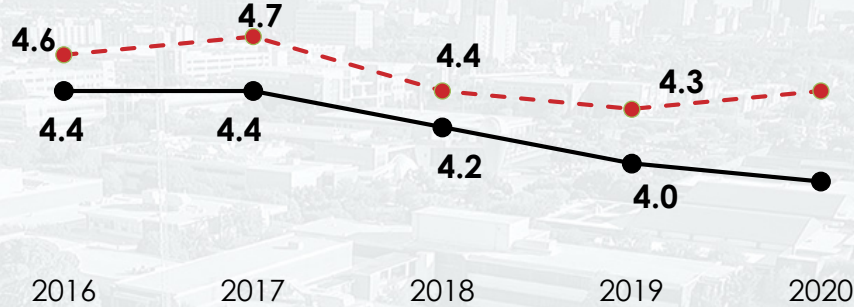

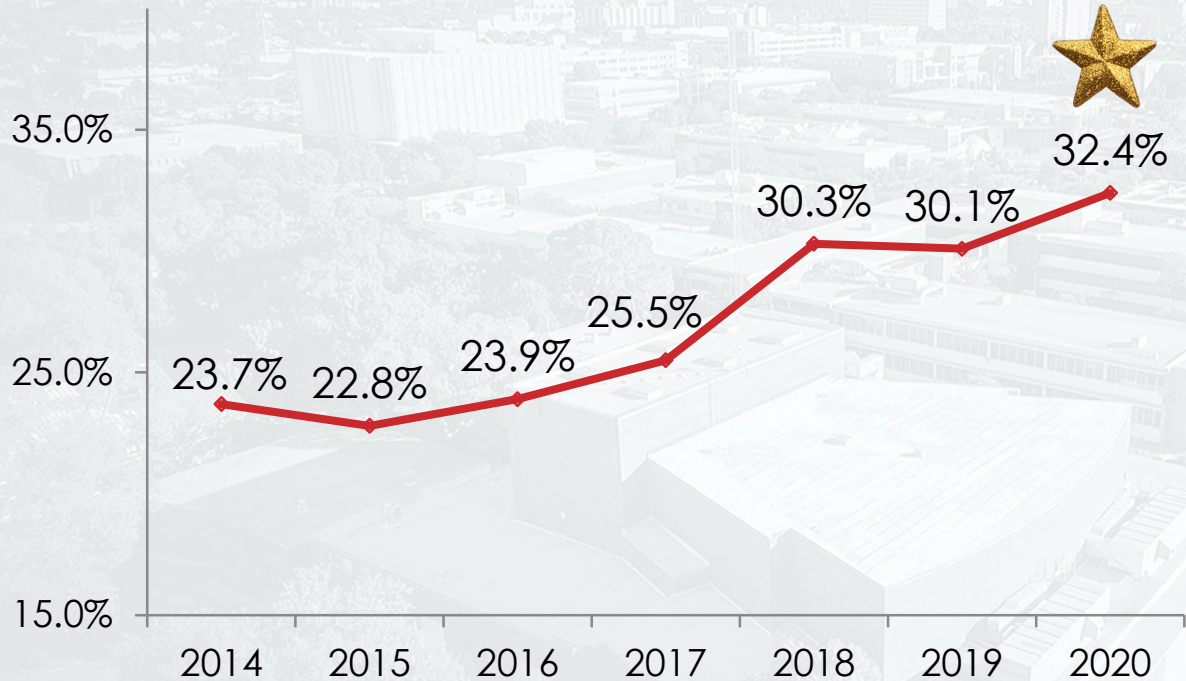

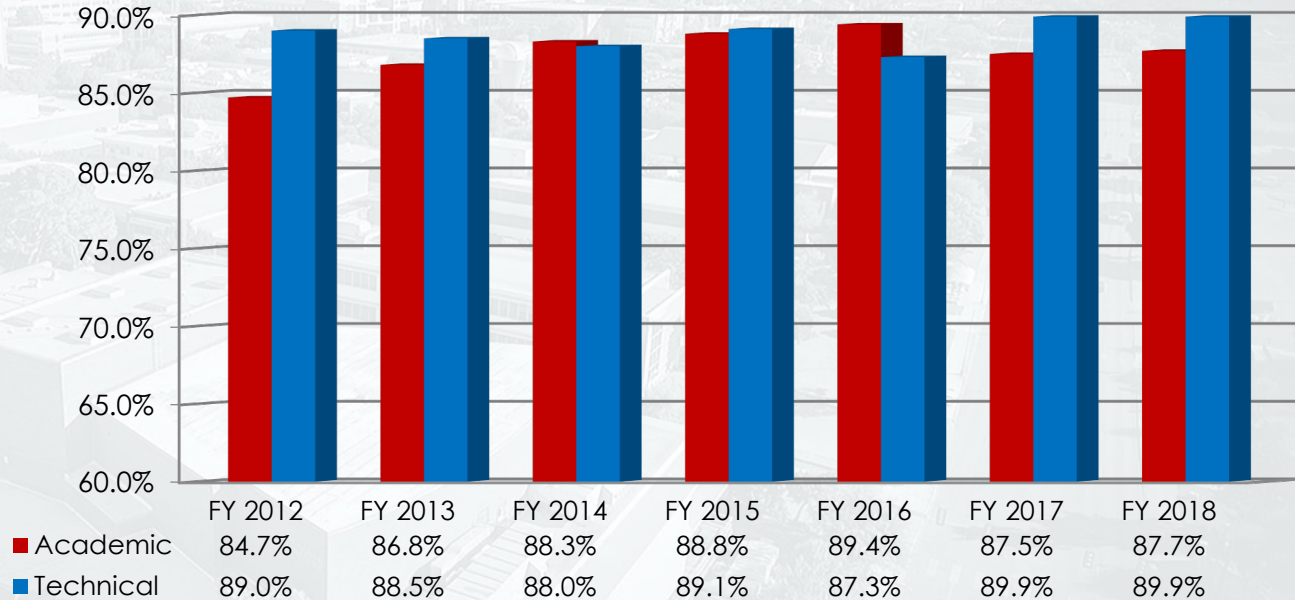

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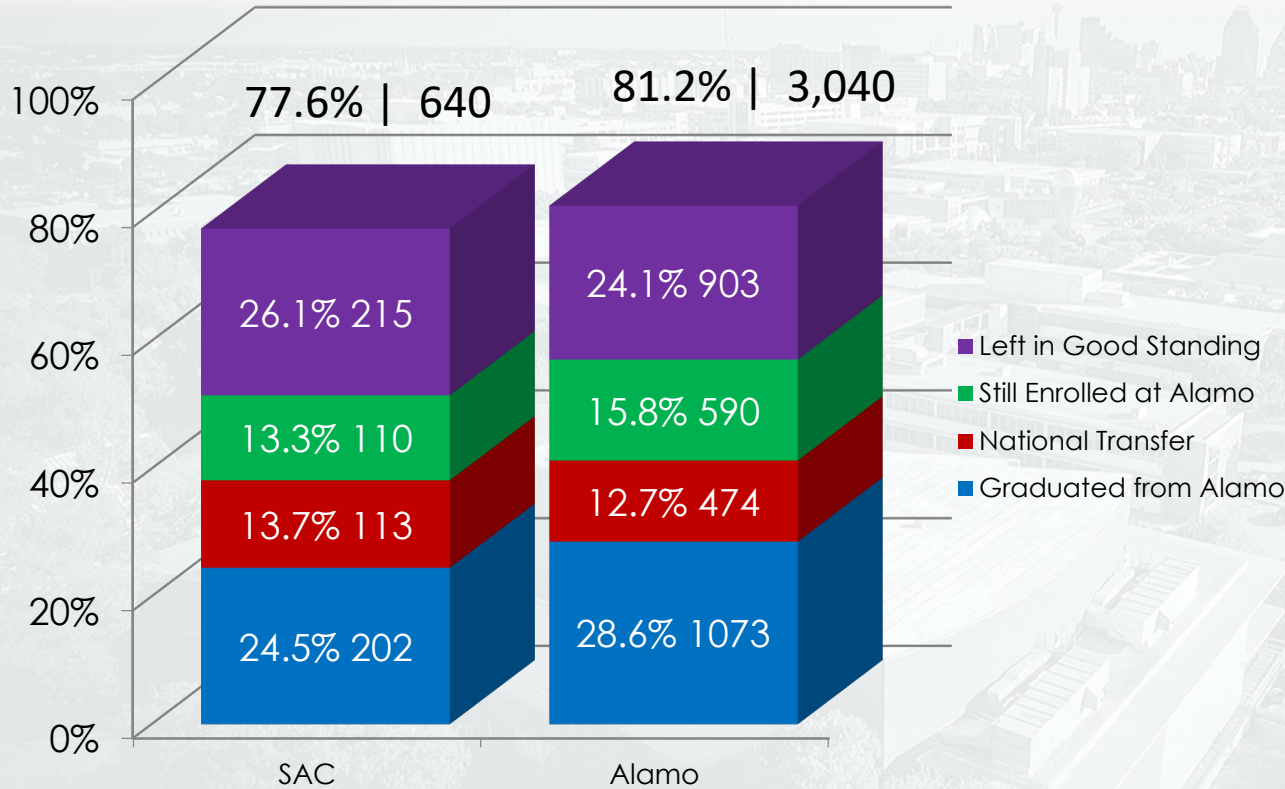
Students Employed and/or Enrolled Within 6 Months of Graduation



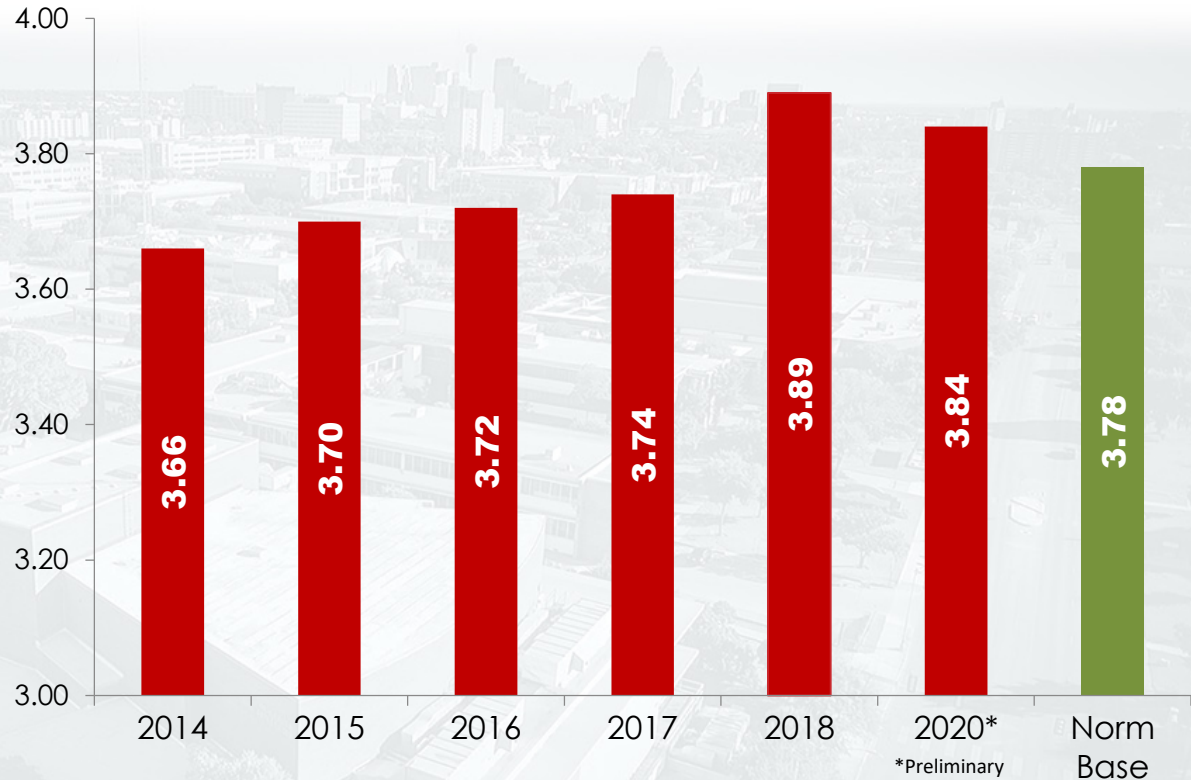

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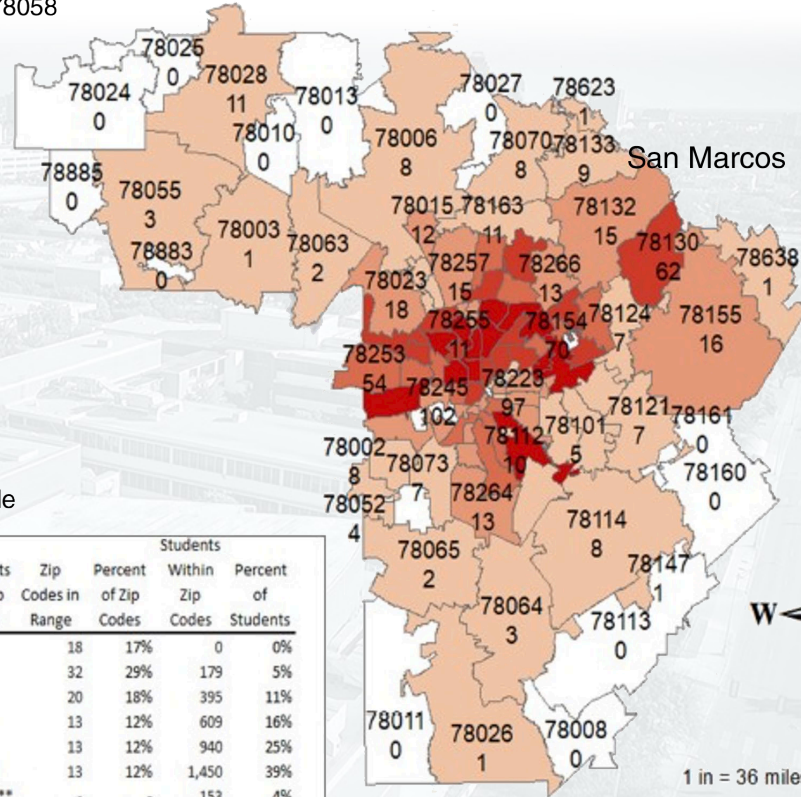
Fall 2020 Headcount by Institute



Fall 2020 Headcount by Zip Code

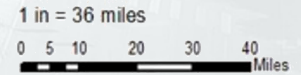

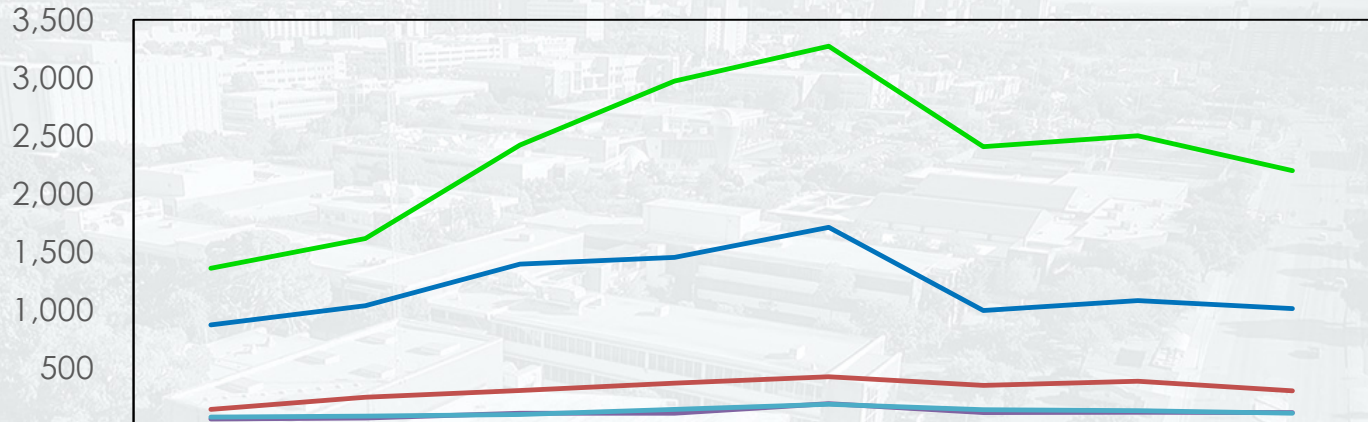

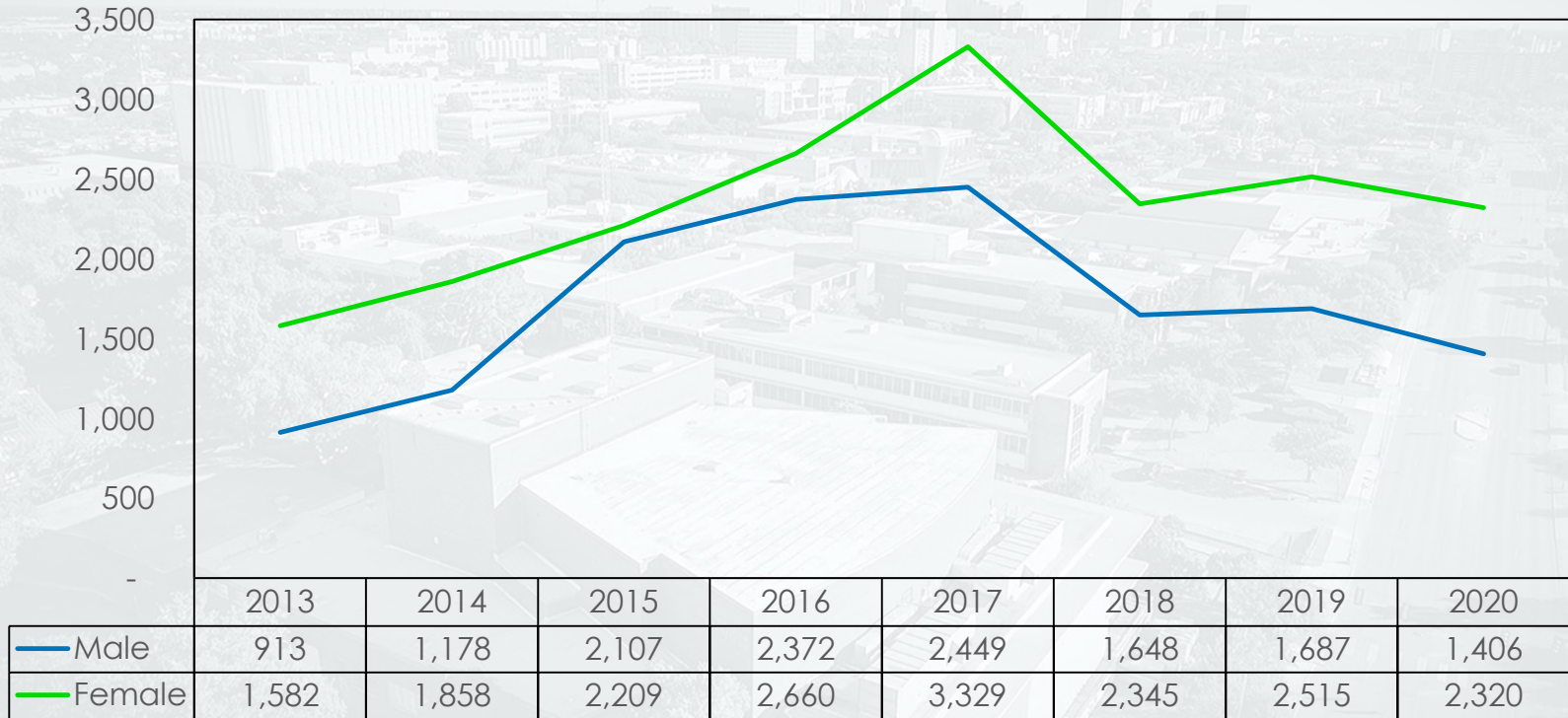
