Fall to Fall Persistence

SPC full time (FT), first time in college (FTIC) Fall-to-Fall Persistence Rates indicate stability and growth when compared to Very Large Community Colleges (VLCC) and Texas statewide trends. While other VLCCs demonstrate inconsistent and decreasing persistence, that of SPC students has risen, as displayed in *Figure A-1*.

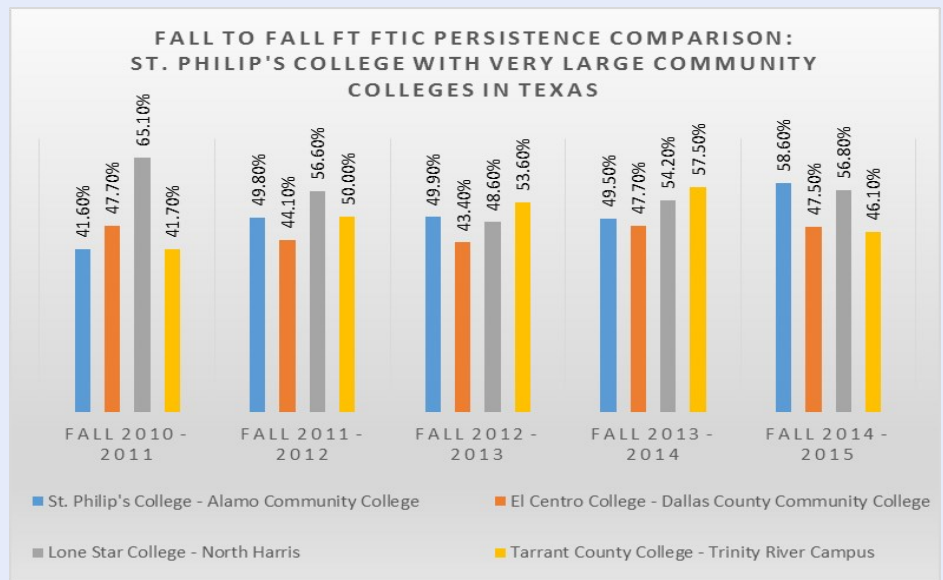


Figure A-1 SPC Fall-to-Fall FT FTIC Persistence Rates Compared to VLCC; Source: THECB Accountability System

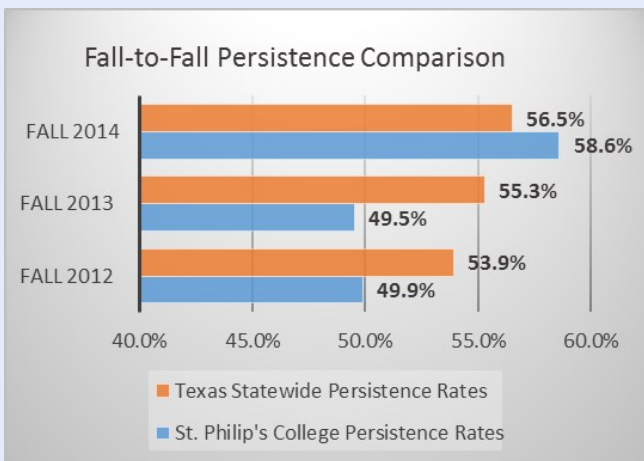


Figure A-2 SPC Fall-to-Fall FT FTIC Persistence Rates Compared to Statewide Institutions; Source: THECB Accountability System
