Thank you for your letter of April 11, 2018, requesting approval to close the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) program in Health Information Technology - Health Management with Technical Specialties, effective spring 2018.

Saint Philip's College has made the decision to close the A.A.S. program due to low enrollment and low numbers of graduates. A detailed teach-out plan was provided. Faculty were informed of the closure during meetings and will not be negatively impacted since they will continue their teaching assignments in the Health Information Technology A.A.S. program. There are no students currently enrolled in the program so none will be impacted by its closure.
