St. Philip's College will close the CAST Lead High School off-campus instructional site (OCIS). There were no students enrolled at the site. Therefore, there were no students to notify; no need for assistance with degree completion; no additional charges or expenses for students due to the teach-out plan; and no need for teach-out agreements with other institutions.

No faculty or staff members were impacted by the change. They will continue to be employed by the institution.
