## Summer Completion and Success Rates

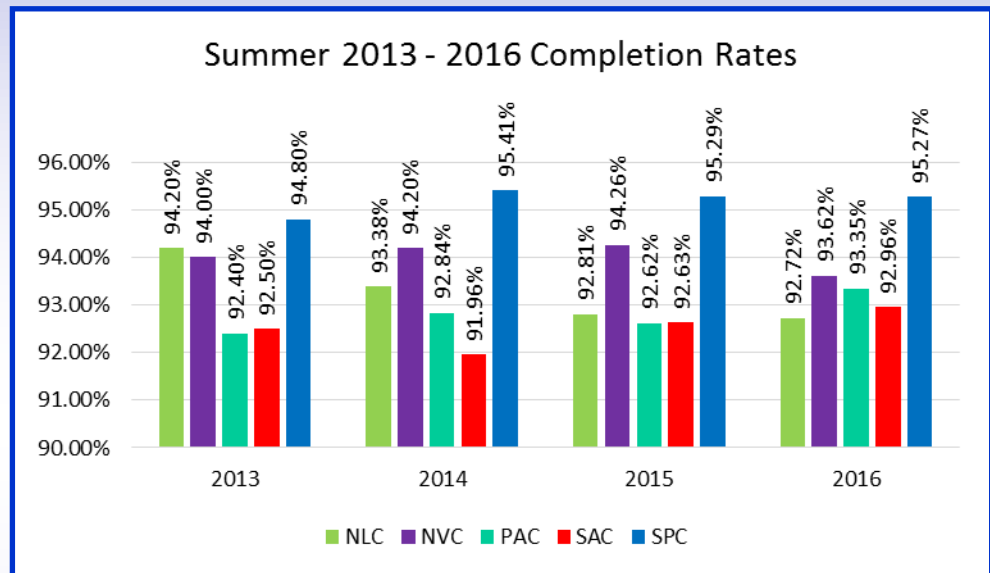


Figure 7-1 Comparison of summer completion rates from 2013 to 2016

### Completion Rate Comparison

As displayed in *Figure 7-1* (above), St. Philip's College summer completion rates exceeded 95% for 3 consecutive years and surpassed other Alamo Colleges District (ACD) institutions over the last 4 summer semesters. Additionally SPC completion rates have fluctuated only 0.14% over the last 3 years, after rising 0.61% from 2013 to 2014; only Northwest Vista College achieved similar consistency, but their greatest fluctuation occurred from 2015 to 2016, when completion dropped 0.64%. Only San Antonio College has seen consistent increases in the completion rate over the last 3 summers, rising from 91.96% in 2014 to 92.96% in 2016.

## SUMMER SUCCESS RATES

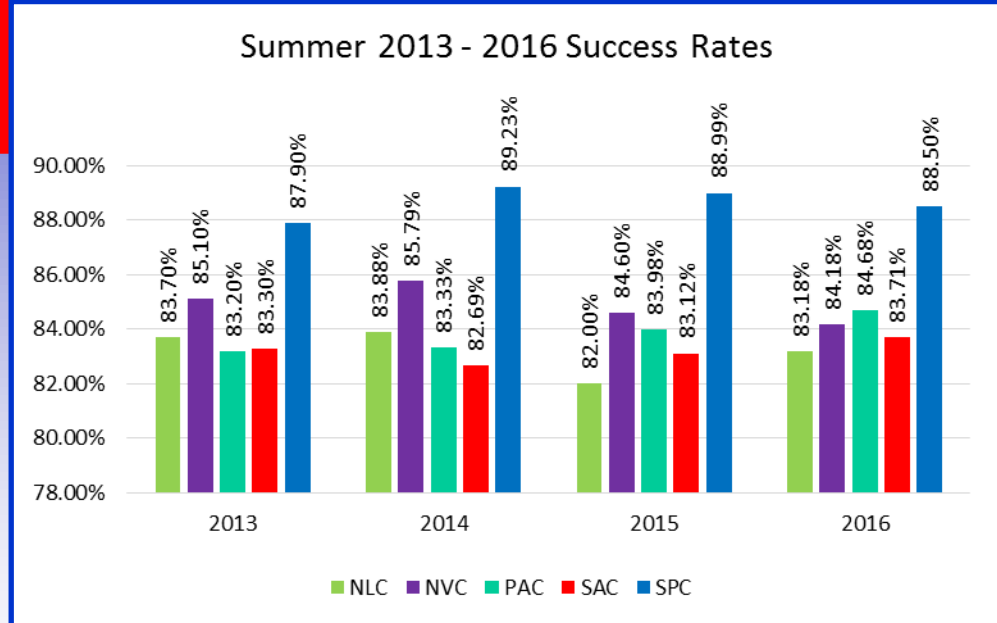


Figure 7-2 Comparison of summer success rates from 2013 to 2016

### Success Rate Comparison

Although SPC maintains the highest ACD institutional success rate for the last 4 years, there has been a slight decline from 2014 to 2016, as seen in *Figure 7-2* (above) and mirrored by Northwest Vista College, whereas Palo Alto College and San Antonio College have experienced consistent increases since 2013 and 2014, respectively.

Despite the decrease, SPC's 2016 success rate is 3.82% higher than PAC (the second highest) and 5.32% higher than Northeast Lakeview College (the lowest).
