St. Philip's College has discontinued its dual credit arrangement at the Byron P. Steele II High School off-campus instructional site because in fall 2018 the high school entered into discussions with Northeast Lakeview College to provide the dual credit courses instead. Students and parents were informed of the change by the Schertz-Cibolo-Universal City ISD administration and Byron P. Steele II High School counselors through both face-to-face and written communication. The high school phased out students from St. Philip's College and moved them to Northeast Lakeview College in spring 2018.

Faculty were not adversely impacted by the site's closure and are still employed by St. Philip's College as online instructors. They had the opportunity to be hired as instructors with Northeast Lakeview College as well.

Please note that when an institution closes a program or instructional site, it has an affirmative obligation to seek closure approval from the Commission at the time the closure decision is made and prior to the cessation of instruction. The closure date is the date students are no longer admitted.
