Admissions and Records returns the student's original license and photo identification. 5. Upon completion and successful approval, the student will receive credit for the following courses totaling 39 hours: <i>CSME 1505, CSME 1348, CSME 1443, CSME 2204, CSME 1453, CSME 1310, CSME 2250, CSME 2343, CSME 1451, CSME 2250, CSME 2251, CSME 2401, and CSME 2310.</i> 6. Credit may take up to one semester to appear on the transcript. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A prospective student should apply to Palo Alto College and complete the steps to enrollment. 2. Upon completion of enrollment steps, the student will be assigned an academic advisor at New Student Orientation (NSO). 3. The student will bring their cosmetology operator license and photo identification to the Admission and Records Office in the Palomino Center. 4. Admissions and Records staff will check www.tdlr.gov to verify an active cosmetology operator license and initiate prior learning credit. 5. Admissions and Records returns the student's original license and photo identification. 6. Upon completion and successful approval, the student will receive credit for the following courses totaling 39 hours: <i>CSME 1505, CSME 1348, CSME 1443, CSME 2204, CSME 1453, CSME 1310, CSME 2250, CSME 2343, CSME 1451, CSME 2251, CSME 2310, and CSME 2401.</i> 7. A High School Programs Coordinator will enroll the student and serve as their assigned advisor through graduation. 2. Once the student receives their cosmetology license, the student or high school programs coordinator will bring the Cosmetology Operator license and photo identification to Admission and Records in the Palomino Center. 3. Admissions and Records staff will check www.tdlr.gov to verify an active cosmetology operator license and initiate prior learning credit. 4. Admissions and Records returns the student's original license and photo identification. 5. Upon completion and successful approval, the student will receive credit for the following courses totaling 39 hours: <i>CSME 1505, CSME 1348, CSME 1443, CSME 2204, CSME 1453, CSME 1310, CSME 2250, CSME 2343, CSME 1451, CSME 2251, CSME 2310, and CSME 2401</i> 6.
