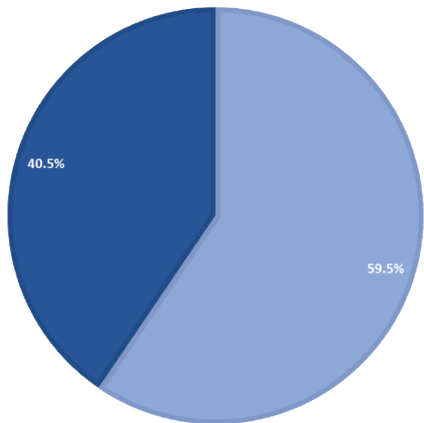

FALL 2021: STUDENT GENDER

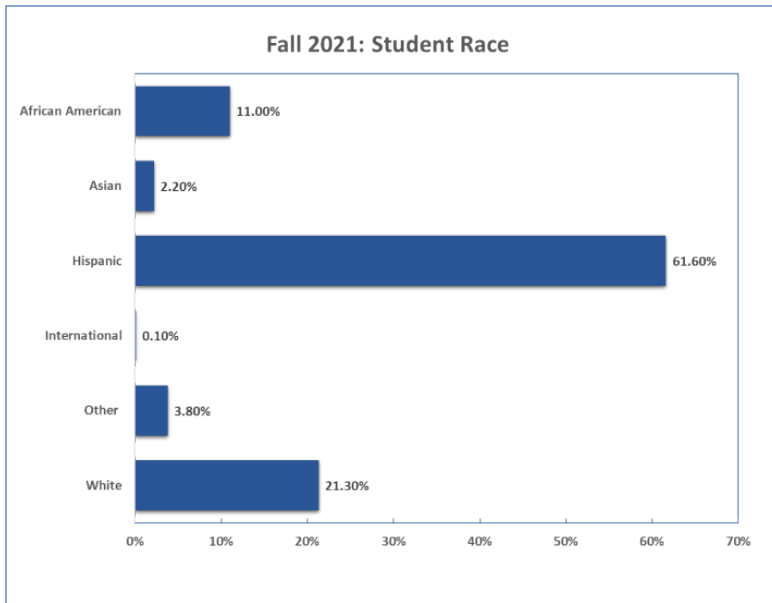

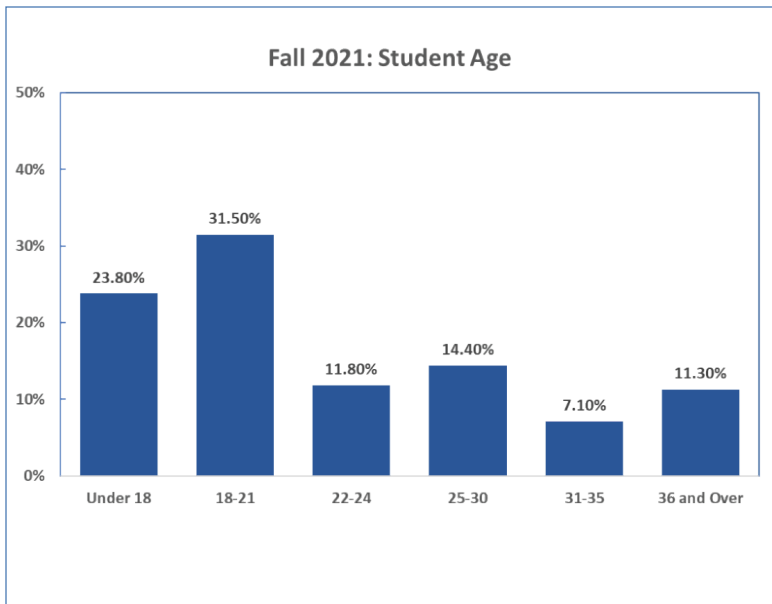
