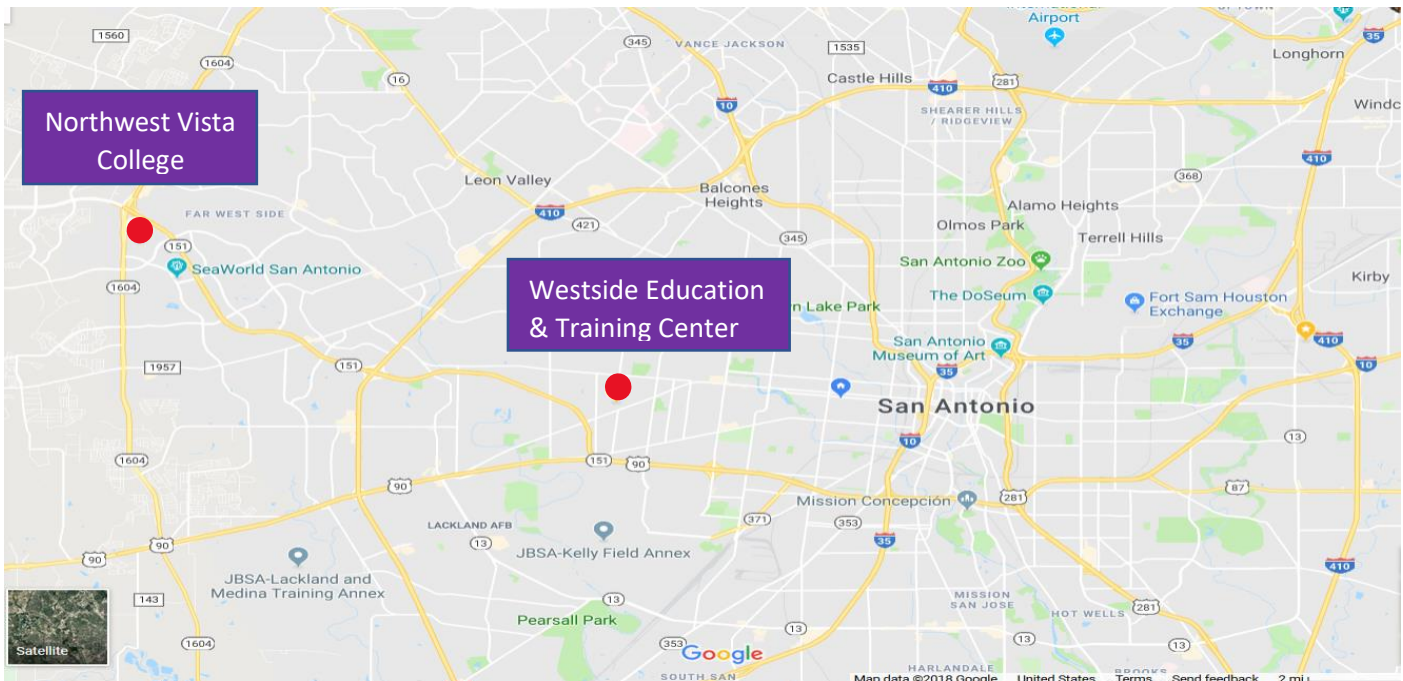
Classes will be offered as a hybrid, in-person and fully online. Face to face/in-person courses are often offered at the following Alamo Colleges' training centers:
