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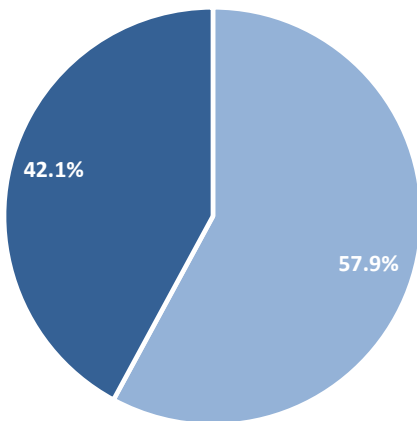

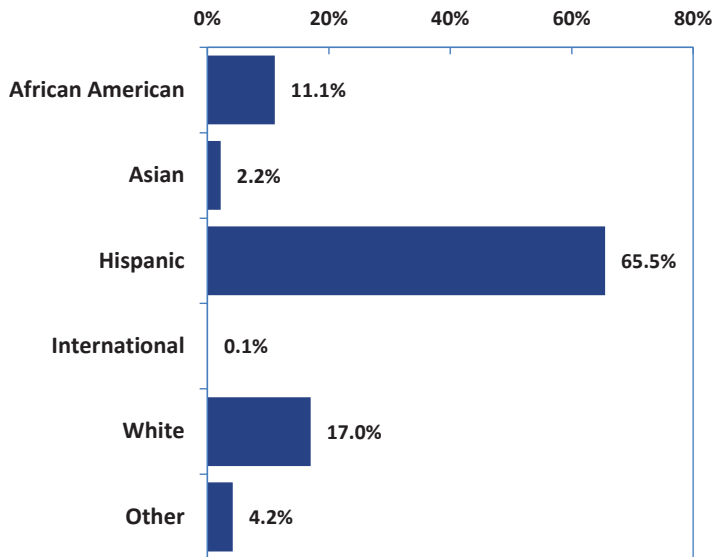

### Fall 2022: Student Race



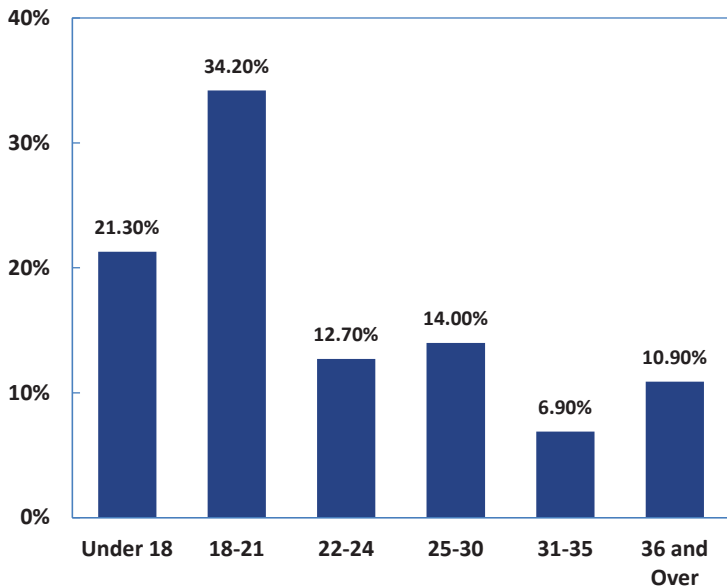
