SPC Degrees and Certificates Awarded Academic Years 2016 to 2019




Figure 37-1: SPC degrees and certificates awarded by academic year 2016 to 2019

As demonstrated in *Figure 37-1* (above), the number of associates degrees awarded by SPC has risen annually since 2016.

Despite a decline in the number of certificates awarded from 2017 to 2018, there was a substantial increase between 2018 and 2019 with 158 more certificates awarded in 2019.

NOTE: The number of certificates and the overall totals include level 3 certificates.






Displayed in *Figure 37-2* (left), Applied Science and Technology has consistently increased degrees and certificates awarded from 2016 to 2019 with 1,162 awards earned during academic year 2019. Associate degrees increased by 239 during the addressed time frame.

Total credentials have increased in the Arts and Sciences division with 650 awards granted during academic year 2019, an increase of 229 since 2016, as seen in *Figure 37-3* (left).
