If you **do** have the **Two-year rule** restriction, then you cannot apply for an F-1 visa since you have to return to your country for two years. However, if you **do not** have the Two-year Rule Restriction, then you are eligible to apply for an F-1 visa by submitting a change of status application (I-539) to USCIS through the International Student Services. The Change-of-Status can be done only if your I-94 card has not expired and the application must be submitted to us at least one month before the expiration date on the I-94 card. To qualify for the Change of Status, you must first complete the Initial F-1 Visa Application process.
