

## Fall 2011 Tutoring Demographics


St. Philip's Tutoring and Technology Center (TnT) offers FREE professional and peer tutoring in more than 15 subject areas. Technology includes: small group study rooms, headphones, computers, calculators, laptop checkout, printers, technical assistance, and adaptive technology for special needs. Below represents data\* on student demographics at St. Philip's College who visited the Tutoring Center at least once in the Fall 2011 Semester.

Number of Fall 2011 Visits to Tutoring Lab by Ethnicity




The total number of visits to the tutoring lab was higher for the Hispanic population at 403, followed by the Black population at 217.

Percentage of Fall 2011 Visits to Tutoring Lab by Gender



The percentage of students visiting the tutoring lab at least one time was higher for the female population at 64%, compared to the male population at 36%.

Percentage of Fall 2011 Visits to Tutoring Lab by Student Type\*\*



The percentage of students visiting the tutoring lab at least one time was higher for the Continuing student population at 63%, compared to lowest of the Undeclared population at 1%.
